The workshop covers the concepts of coin-value, time, addition, subtraction, multiplication, division, fractions and working memory games designed to improve students' ability to retain math facts and avoid careless errors. Students will be given a pretest to check what skills they need to work on and will then focus on those specific skills during the content sessions. The approach builds hands-on, concrete representation of math concepts using blocks and drawings, and guides students in transitioning those concepts into the abstract (numerical) representation. The workshop is taught by an Educational Therapist trained in Making Math Real.

In this multi-sensory, interactive workshop students will investigate the sound, sight, spelling, and meaning of words through word-sorts geared to their own level. They will discover how rhyme impacts spelling, how to look for meaningful word parts to help in reading, how words shape-shift and yet retain their meaning, how to correctly visualize letters/words in the 'mind's-eye', how to accurately form letters, and how prefixes and suffixes impact spelling and semantics. We invite students to act like word scientists, investigating clues in regards to the structure of English words, and drawing their own conclusions about spelling rules and how words carry their meaning. By the end of the workshop, students will walk away with a deeper understanding of word structure, word meaning, and spelling. This workshop is taught by an Educational Therapist using programs such as Wilson, Barton, and Words Their Way.

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
